Partner Steven Badger was quoted in the *New York Law Journal* article entitled "Silverstein Seeks Unsealing of Property Damage Deal." The article discusses Larry Silverstein's World Trade Center Properties opposing and seeking to unseal a settlement reached by its property insurers and other business loss plaintiffs with airlines and aviation security defendants alleged to be responsible for the 9/11 Terrorist Attack.

The litigation was recently settled for \$1.2 billion, reportedly the largest subrogation recovery ever obtained.
